Treehouse Children's Museum Policy and Programming Changes

Effective September 1, 2010

Input from members and visitors helped us revise our schedule, programs, and policies. These changes go into effect on September 1, 2010. We appreciate your feedback and your cooperation.

Policy Changes

1. Hours of Operation

Because of increased demand for morning and evening education programs, Treehouse's public hours are now:

On Track to Reading Mondays	10 a.m. to 3 p.m. (September - May)
Holiday and Summer Mondays	10 a.m. to 5 p.m. (June - Aug & Labor Day, the Monday after Christmas, MLK Jr. Day, President's Day & Memorial Day)
Tuesdays through Thursdays	10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Fridays	10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
Saturdays	10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

2. Regular Admission (change in age distinctions)

Visitors age 1-12 yrs:	\$6	•	Visitors age 13 yrs+:	\$5
Member children with cards plus up to two adults 18 yrs+:	FREE			

3. Age of Responsible Adults

Treehouse staff and Board work very hard to provide a safe, secure environment for children and families. To further ensure the safety of our visitors **all children age 0 to 17 must be accompanied by an adult age 18 yrs and up.** Additionally, **all adults 18 yrs and up must be accompanied by a child age 0 to 12 yrs.** Adults wishing to visit the Museum without children should call ahead to arrange a guided tour.

Programming Changes

1. Toddler Time is now On Track to Reading

- *On Track to Reading* will be held all day on Mondays, September - May. (No longer on Wednesdays.)
- *On Track to Reading* admission is \$3 for children age 1 - 5, and \$1 for adults age 18 +. Children age 6 - 17 pay regular \$6 admission
- *On Track to Reading* will not be held in the summer or on statewide Monday school holidays (Labor Day, the Monday after Christmas, MLK Jr. Day, President's Day, and Memorial Day.) Regular admission will apply these days.

2. Theater Thursday and ParticiPlayhouse are now offered daily as Step On Stage.

In response to increased demand for theater programming, Treehouse will offer daily theater arts activities included in regular admission.

Tuesday - Friday at 4 p.m. (Sept - May)
Summer Weekdays at 1 and 3 p.m.
Saturdays at 11 a.m., 1, and 3 p.m.

3. Birthday Parties at Treehouse

Treehouse Parties now offers two kinds of parties – one with lots of time to play, and the other with custom Treehouse activities just for your party. Two-hour Playtime Parties are \$90 for members or \$120 for non members. Included are admission to the party for up to 30 people (Treehouse requires one adult age 18 yrs+ for every 5 children), time in the Party Room for treats and gifts, paper products, and time to explore the exhibits. Treehouse will also provide a staff member to help with supplies and clean up. Treehouse is now offering Custom Deluxe Storybook Parties that are \$275 for Treehouse members or \$300 for non members. These parties include all the elements of a Playtime Party plus customized add-ons. Please see the Treehouse website for more details about Deluxe Storybook Parties.
