

Preschool Puppet Parade

Tours at Treehouse

Plan *now* to visit Treehouse with your preschool during the **2010-2011 school year.**



- Preschool visits can be scheduled Tuesdays - Fridays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- Preschool tours are 90 minutes and include a Puppet *Participatory Story Activity*.
- Tours also include plenty of exploration time.
- Treehouse can accommodate groups of 15 to 60 preschool students. Groups of more than 30 children may be divided among multiple tour guides. *Treehouse may overlap preschool groups with other tour groups.*
- Cost for Licensed Preschools with a reservation for 15 or more students is **\$3.75 per student. Adult Chaperones and Teachers are free.** Groups with fewer than 15 students do not qualify for the preschool rate and will be charged regular admission rates (\$6 per child and \$5 per adult). *Treehouse Membership Cards are not valid for Preschool Tours. Siblings staying with tour groups are \$3.75. They are charged regular price (\$6) if they do not plan to stay with the group.*
- Treehouse is wheelchair accessible.

Open since 1992, Treehouse Children's Museum is a private, non-profit museum featuring dozens of interactive exhibits and displays that encourage literacy and language development, the arts, and higher level thinking skills. Treehouse is supported by donations, admissions, memberships and grants. The Museum moved to its permanent home in The Junction development in downtown Ogden in August 2006.
